Q: How much are dues?

A: Our district dues are \$13, however, some sponsoring Kiwanis clubs may help pay a portion of the cost for your club.

Q: When do I need to turn in dues?

A: Club dues need to be turned in by December 1st to be considered an official Key Club member. Official Key Club members are eligible to attend international events, run for office, and more!

Q: What are early bird dues?

A: Early bird dues are dues turned in by November 1st. Clubs that pay early bird dues are awarded and recognized!

Q: What are dues used for?

A: Dues are used to help cover training resources, travel, and other items for members. Key Club international works hard to keep dues as low as possible!

CLUB SPOTLIGHT Lincolr East High School

Lincoln East Key Club School in Nebraska has recently helped hygiene kits and create Huskers Helping the Homeless. Their club received \$2000 from the Youth Opportunities Fund this last year. They are using the grant to create hygiene kits to be donated around Lincoln. The grant was enough to make 600 kits. They included items like toothpaste, toothbrush, body wash, a shampoo, conditioner, a towel, and several other necessities. The Key Clubbers have been making these kits during their meetings. 


